Accessing the Voice Mail System

Calling the Voice Mail System for the First Time

- Lift the handset (or use handsfree dialling).
- 2. Dial the Message Centre extension 595. The system prompts you for your passcode.
- 3. Enter your default passcode 1111 .
- 4. Press 1. The system prompts you for a new passcode (you must change the passcode).
- 5. Enter your new passcode. Your new passcode must have the same number of digits as the default passcode. You cannot re-enter the default passcode, or use or in your new passcode.
- 6. The system asks you to re-enter your new passcode for confirmation. Enter your new passcode again.
- 7. The system asks you to record your name. Say only your name, for example: 'Christine Conner'. Speak immediately after the tone and press any key when you have finished.
- 8. Press 1 to accept, 2 to review or 3 to discard your name and re-record it.
- 9. The system prompts you for a greeting. Keep your greeting short and professional. For example:

"You have reached Christine Conner. I am unable to attend to your call at present. Please leave your name, number and a brief message and I will get back to you as soon as possible."

- 10. To end the recording, press any key. The system plays back your greeting. Press 1 to accept it, 2 to review it or 3 to discard and re-record it.
- 11. You will then be prompted to define your personal contact numbers. Please press any key to skip these steps.
- 12. You have now successfully set up your mailbox and can send and listen to messages.
